O-YEAH is a program designed to support older youth and young adults who are experiencing emotional and behavioral challenges, to successfully transition to adulthood.

Supports include

LIVING (housing)
WORKING (employment)
LEARNING (school/training)
BELONGING (friendships)
HEALING (health)
BEING SAFE

When do YOU need O-YEAH?

When you...

- Are approaching the age of 18 or older
- No longer have support services available
- Difficulty finding and or keeping a job
- Are you finding yourself moving from place to place
- Feeling lonely
- In need of support to continue your education
- Are you finding your transition to adulthood difficult

Planning

You will develop a Futures Plan based on your individual vision of adulthood. You will explore your needs and strengths and what supports may be necessary for you to achieve your hopes and dreams.

Enrollment

O-YEAH is a voluntary program. You shape and guide your own plans for the future with the help of a Transitional Coordinator.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Between the ages of 17-25 years old
- Medicaid eligibility
- Mental health diagnosis or behavioral/ emotional challenges
